

## ACCOMMODATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (2026.4)

### 1. Eligibility

Applicants must be international students at TUMSAT (with “Student” visa status as of April 2026. Students who have extended their graduation period (e.g. Repeating the same academic year) are not eligible to apply.

*Note: Former residents of TUMSAT accommodations may also apply,) but priority will be given to new applicants who have never lived in a university dormitory.*

At move-in, the dorm collects: current month fee, following month fee, and the move-in deposit. Details on payment methods will be provided after admission to the dorm is confirmed.

(1) Monthly Fee

The full monthly fee is required even if you move in or out in the middle of a month.

(2) Utilities

Costs for electricity, gas, and water used for your private life.

(3) Move-in Deposit

Used to cover repair costs due to intentional or negligent damage to the room and any unpaid fees. The remaining balance will be refunded upon move-out, or additional charges may be collected if necessary.

(4) Other Costs

- For Single A rooms, a fee will be charged for using the shared shower, toilet, dining room, and kitchen (equivalent to utilities).
- Laundry (operated by an external contractor): 300 JPY per use (Washing machine: 200 JPY per cycle + Dryer: 100 JPY per 30 minutes).
