● Outline of this program “Emergency Student Support Handout”

The novel coronavirus pandemic is having a significant economic effect on the lives of students, such as by dramatically reducing household income and also severely lowering or completely wiping out part-time income. As it is conceivable that students, especially those who do not live at home, may be forced to drop out of their university or other educational institution due to the further deterioration of their situation because of the impact of the novel coronavirus pandemic, those who face difficulties continuing their studies at their university or other educational institution shall receive support in the form of a cash handout.

● Handout Amount

Students exempt from residence tax: 200,000 yen

Other students: 100,000 yen

● Regarding the application for this program

Please refer to “**Emergency Student Support Handout for Continuing Studies: Application Guide (for Students)**” for more information. The applicant will be judged comprehensively considering applicant's current situation.

**Please apply for this program even if you do not meet all of the requirements but are in difficulty continuing your studies.**

However, please note that due to the budget for this program, not all applicants are eligible for this program.

Total income in 2020(from January to May): 300,000 yen

The funds will be sent via bank transfer to an account in the name of you, the applicant. If you do not have an account in your name, please open an account that you can use before you apply for the handout.
